

SHORELINE QUILTERS GUILD

BLOCK OF THE MONTH: "NOT YOUR GRANDMOTHER'S SAMPLER QUILT"

[Fabric and General Guidelines apply to all of the blocks in the quilt.]*

Fabric: Use one of the following color combinations: Red/Black/and White **OR** Grey/Yellow/Black and White

General Guidelines: All seams are $\frac{1}{4}$ inch, press to the darkest fabric unless otherwise indicated, make use of spray starch or sizing to stabilize bias edges – and use all of your other "good quilting" skills.

BLOCK 3 - FROM THE HEART

Block 3 "From the Heart" has no picture/drawing and minimal instructions because it is a creative block from your heart.

Cut or create a 14" square of background fabric. To create a 14" square consider some of the following ideas:

- 4 Patch: each square is 7"
- 9 Patch: each square is 5"
- Half square triangle: each square is 15" and this will make two background squares
- Strata: same width strips X 15" and enough to make a 15" square
- Strata: differing width strips X 15" and enough to make a 15" square
- Use your imagination

Attach one or more hearts to the background square. This may be done by hand applique or machine applique (I recommend Heat 'n Bond Lite for fusing).

True up to 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " and have fun!
